



Maurice Hawk PTA International Fair *Poster Guidelines*

Welcome to the Maurice Hawk first International Fair poster design team! The following serves as a guideline for designing the posters. Let your creativity soar and have fun working on the project!

Materials: 22 x 40" or 36" x 48" white or black tri-fold display board preferred.

Content: You may use our 6-slide template (online) or use these guidelines with your own creative layout! (Number 1-6 are required; number 7-12 are suggestions)

1. Country's name, continent.
2. Show where your country is located on the world map (sample picture included at the end of this document).
3. Draw the country's flag.
4. Country Facts: capital city, language, currency, climate, size (in square miles), population, location and/or neighboring countries.
5. List one or two important citizens, and explain what he/she is famous for. For example, who leads the country? Who is a famous sports star, artist or scientist?
6. Draw or put a picture of a major landmark and write a description of the landmark. Example: Mount Rushmore (US), Great Wall of China, Buckingham Palace (UK).
7. List some common words from this countries' national language. How do they say hello, goodbye, school and friends?
8. What is the national anthem?
9. Show a popular sport in this country.
10. Show this country's special food/dish, especially a popular healthy food.
11. What special clothes do people from this country wear?
12. Write a special holiday from this country.
13. Write two things that this country is known for.
14. List an animal or a plant that is special to this country, and a few facts about it.
15. Optional: Create a travel brochure to learn about the people, places and things that make the country special.
